

Marin Deanery Report to Diocesan Convention 2015

2015 was a quiet program year for Marin Deanery. Our twelve churches maintained active ministries and the priests in charge continued to offer core leadership to the deanery. The deanery administered grants to help fund churches' special projects.

The Marin clericus and the priests in charge group, comprised of rectors, vicars, and priests in charge of the various churches in the Deanery, met regularly and have formed a strong working relationship both among themselves and between the churches in their care. The Episcopal churches of Marin County remain active in their communities and enjoy high visibility, acting both as community centers and places of worship.

We awarded two grants this year: one to expand a church's Godly Play program and the second in support of a summer arts camp for economically disadvantaged children. Both, we are pleased to report, have made a positive difference in the lives of their participants.

The deanery is looking forward to continued development of the strong working relationships and partnerships that shape our shared mission as the Episcopal Church in Marin.
